

About Norwegian Journal of Geology (NJG)

Norwegian Journal of Geology (NJG) (eISSN: 2387-5852) is a peer-reviewed, diamond open access journal published by the Geological Society of Norway. It was first published in 1905 and has now reached over 100 volumes. Until 2001, the journal was published under its Norwegian name “Norsk Geologisk Tidsskrift” (NGT; eISSN: 1502-5322). Since 2018, NJG articles are only published online.

NJG has a Journal Impact Factor (JIF) of 1.508 ([2020](#)), Scientific Journal Ranking (SJR) score of 0.666 ([2020](#)) and a CiteScore of 3.2 ([2020](#)).

Aims and Scope

The Norwegian Journal of Geology (NJG) is a geoscience journal publishing research articles, thematic papers and monographs covering all aspects of geoscience in Scandinavia, and the North Atlantic, Arctic, and Antarctic regions.

NJG mainly publishes regular-length articles that presents new knowledge or a review of a topic relevant to its readership. Thematic papers are also accepted. Monographs and collections of regular-length articles on a specific subject are published as special issues.

NJG aims to be the leading journal on Norwegian regional geoscience and an attractive journal for Scandinavian, Arctic, and Antarctic geoscientific research of relevance to its readership. The journal serves the wide geoscientific community in Norway, including universities, industry, public institutions, and non-governmental organizations.

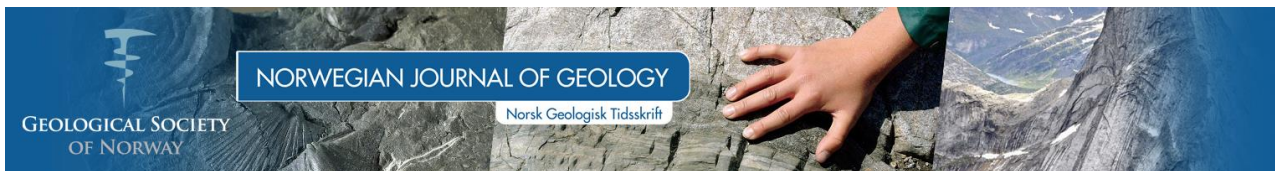
Open access policy

Ownership and editorial independence

The Norwegian Journal of Geology (NJG) is published by the [Geological Society of Norway](#) (NGF) – a non-political, learned society for Norwegian geoscientists founded in 1905. The society, and thereof NJG, is financed by member subscriptions, conference registration fees and donations from companies and institutions.

The editors of NJG are selected by the board of NGF.



The Geological Survey of Norway supports NJG with technical solutions such as email servers (thereof the @ngu.no in the editor email address). These services are of great help to the society and NJG. At the same time, such support does not influence the editorial handling or peer-review process of manuscripts coming from NGU employees. The editorial team takes extra caution in handling manuscripts submitted by colleagues. These are handled by the least conflicted editor and are always reviewed by external researchers.
