NJG publications are easily and freely available for everyone via the journal's website: <https://njg.geologi.no/>. Easy access is also provided by the journal being indexed by major scholarly systems such as ROAD, Crossref, Scopus and Web of Science.

## Copyright and licensing

Author(s), or their institution(s) if required, holds the copyright of their work, with first publication rights granted to the Norwegian Journal of Geology (NJG).

All publications by NJG are distributed under an [Attribution 4.0 International licence \(CC BY 4.0\)](#), which means that the authors allow for third parties to read, share and adapt the published work for any purpose as long as the original work is properly credited.

## Author self-archiving and preprints

Authors are free to archive any version of their manuscript in a personal or international website, in repositories and preprint servers, prior to and after publication. Authors should declare any such publication of their manuscript upon submission to NJG. Following acceptance, the DOI link to the published article should be added to the self-archived manuscript.

## Publication fee

It is entirely free of charge to publish in NJG (no submission fee, no publication fee, no page fee, no colour-figure fee etc.). Everyone can freely access the online NJG publications.
